# Hadith

Hazarat Ubai bin kab (ra) narrates that I said to the Holy Prophet Muhammad (sa), O Messenger of Allah, I invoke Allah's peace and blessings upon you copiously, how much time should I aim for this, he said as much time you think is proper, I submitted a quarter of my time, he said as much time as you wish, but it would be better for you if you could devout more time, I said half of my time, he said whatever you wish, but it would be still better for you if you were to increase it, than I said two third's of my time, he said as much as you wish, but it would still be better for you if you were to increase it, I said shall I devout all my time, supplications reciting salat on you, he said than it will take care of all you worries and your sins will be forgiven.





## **Does the Holy Prophet (sa) require our Durood?**

*The Holy Prophet(sa) once stated: O people, on the Day of Judgement those who will be most worthy of salvation from it's fear and risks will be those who most sent Durood upon me during their lives. Certainly, the blessings of Allah and His angels was sufficient for me as is mentioned in the verse, "Certainly Allah and His angels call down blessings on the Prophet". But Allah ordered the believers to do as well so that they may be rewarded because of it.*

## The Promised Messiah (as) personal experience


Once it so happened that I was completely absorbed in invoking Allah's blessing upon the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, for a long period of time because I was certain that the paths of reaching Allah the Almighty are very narrow and cannot be found except through the intermediation of the Holy Prophetsa. As Allah also says: (...and seek the way of approach unto Him... ) After a period of time I saw a vision that two water-men enter my house, one from the interior side and the other from the exterior. On their shoulders they were carrying waterskins filled with the light Divine. They said: "This is a consequence of the blessings you invoked upon Muhammad (sa)."

## How Durood should be recited? The Promised Messiah (as) explains

"You must not recite Durood Shareef as a mere ritual or habit. It should come from the fountain of love within your heart. For example, do not recite Durood as people do generally, like a parrot. They are not sincere towards the Holy Prophet (sa) ... Before reciting Durood Shareef one must truly believe that there neither was, nor will there ever be – since the beginning of time until the end of time – anybody who is more saturated in the love of the Holy Prophet (sa) than himself."






