HAZRAT KHALIFATUL-MASIH V RA

Then the Holy Prophet ﷺ admonishes us not to quarrel with each other. Quarrels take place over petty matters... Then we are directed not to have **enmity** towards each other. Enmities start from petty matters. Hearts are filled with spite and malice. Some people are always on the lookout for an opportunity to avenge them, while the instruction is not to have **enmity** with, nor malice for, anyone. Once a Companion (ra) humbly asked the Holy Prophet ﷺ to give him simple, but unforgettable advice in a few words. The Holy Prophet ﷺ advised him to **shun anger** and then again he said, **shun anger**. When you keep in your mind that you should shun anger, then malice and spite will go away automatically.
