MKA MIDDLESEX DISTRIBUTES FOOD AND WARM ESSENTIALS

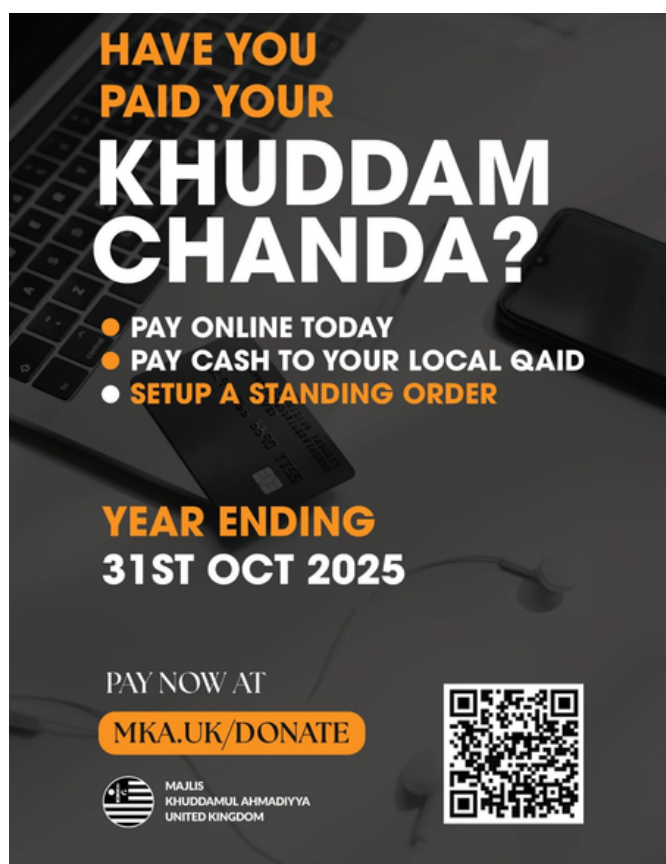
MKA Middlesex, with participation from the Hounslow North, Southall, and Greenford Qiadats, organised a community service initiative to support the homeless.
