

Chapter 9, Verse 105

وَقُلِ اعْمَلُوْا فَسَيَرَى اللهُ عَمَلَكُمْ وَرَسُولُهُ وَالْمُؤْمِنُونَ ﴿ وَسَتُرَدُّوْنَ اللهُ عَمَلُونَ ﴿ وَسَتُرَدُّوْنَ اللهُ عَلِمِ الْغَيْبِ وَالشَّهَا وَقِ فَيُنَبِّئُكُمْ بِمَا كُنْتُمْ تَعْمَلُونَ ﴿

Translation:

And say, 'Work, and Allah will surely see your work and also His Messenger and the believers. And you shall be brought back to Him Who knows the unseen and the seen; then He will tell you what you used to do.'

Friday Sermon Highlight

Huzoor (aba)'s Message – Delivered on 28th November 2025, shared by the Review of Religions:

His Holiness (aba) said that, as previously mentioned, there were some hypocrites who did not accompany the Muslim army on this expedition, and they presented various excuses for not going. In fact, this has even been recorded in the Holy Qur'an. It was the Holy Prophet's (sa) practice that whenever he returned to Madinah from a journey, he would first stop at the mosque to offer voluntary prayers. The Holy Prophet (sa) did the same when he returned from the Expedition of Tabuk. Thereafter, the Holy Prophet (sa) remained in the mosque as people came to meet him. These people also included those hypocrites who had not accompanied the Muslim army, and in order to preserve their reputation, they presented various excuses to the Holy Prophet (sa). Historians say that such people numbered around 80, while others say they were more.



Khuddam Time (General Meeting)

Qiadat Putney Heath held their First General Meeting on Friday, 7th November 2025, at Putney Heath, Salat Centre, with 32 Khuddam attending and participating actively. The first session began with Tilawat, followed by Khuddam Pledge and a detailed presentation on Risala Al-Wasiyat by Secretary Wasaya, Farrukh Khan Sahib. Beyond The Rakat
