NOVEMBER

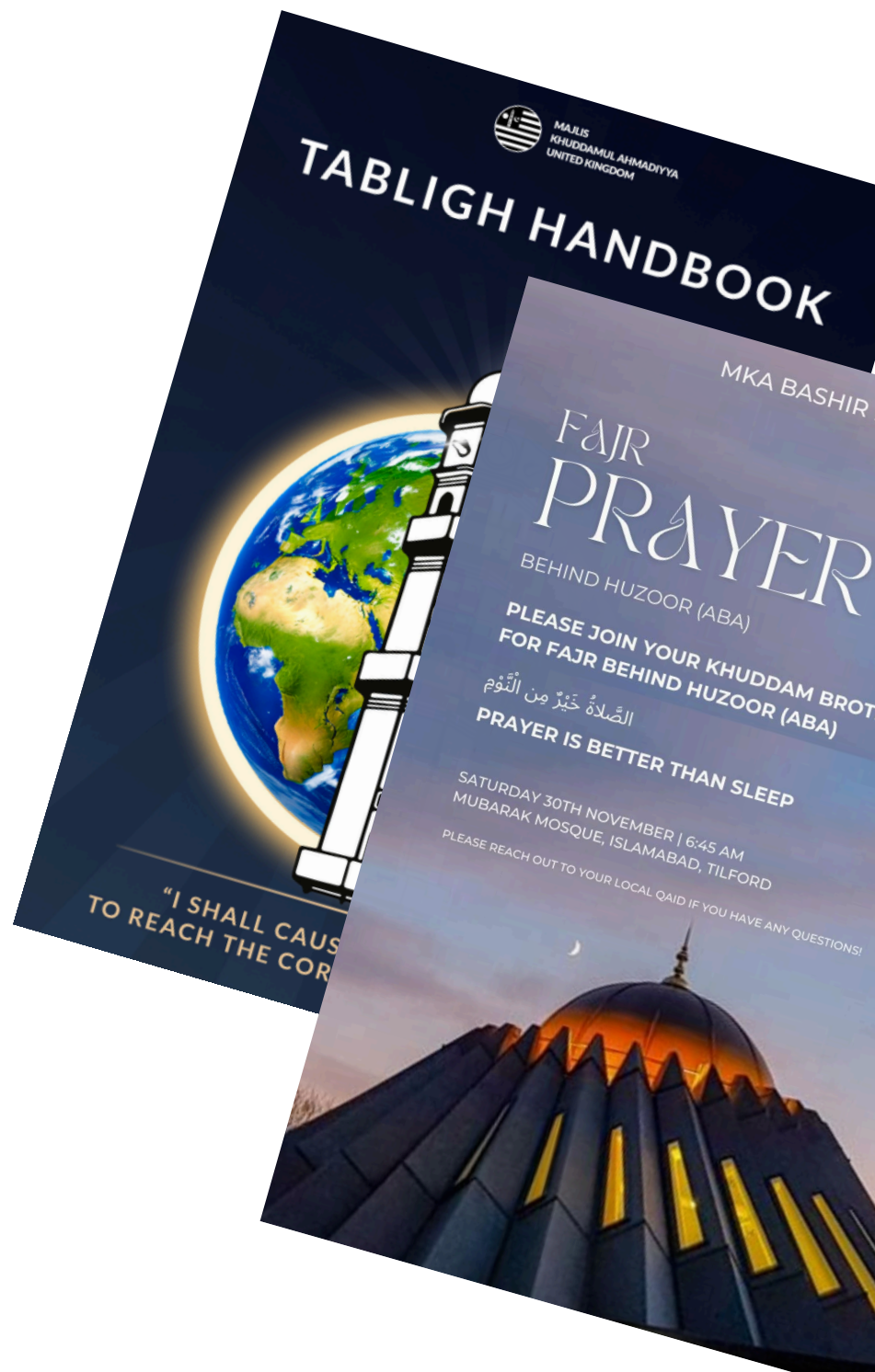

JANUARY

Serving with a fresh start

As the new year began, Khuddam across Bashir Region stepped into 2025 with sleeves rolled up and hearts full of purpose. The month opened with one of our most recognisable initiatives — the New Year's Day Street Clean. From Oxford to Swindon and Walton, Khuddam, Atfal, and Ansar took to the streets armed with high-vis jackets, gloves, and bin bags, determined to start the year in the service of their communities.

This annual act of khidmat is more than just a clean-up — it is a public expression of gratitude and responsibility. By serving their neighbourhoods at dawn on the first morning of the year, Khuddam quietly demonstrate the true Islamic spirit of service, humility, and care for others.

The initiative drew positive attention from local councils and media outlets, with coverage appearing in the Oxford Mail, ITV News, and on Khuddam.org.uk, showcasing the impact of youth-led community service.

Alongside this, Bashir Region launched its Faith & Health Ashra, encouraging Khuddam to combine physical fitness with spiritual rejuvenation. Morning “Fajr Fit-Hikes” in Tilford offered a refreshing start to the year — body, mind, and soul aligned in remembrance of Allah.

FEBRUARY

Brotherhood in Every Qiadat

February was a month that perfectly captured the heart of Bashir Region — learning, brotherhood, and spiritual renewal. Local Ijtemas took centre stage across Walton-on-Thames, Guildford, Reading, and Oxford, where Khuddam and Atfal gathered for weekends filled with competitions, prayers, and inspiring discussions. Each qiadat brought its own unique energy, yet all shared the same goal: strengthening faith and unity under the guidance of Khilafat.

A truly memorable highlight came at the Walton Ijtema, where Khuddam spent a late evening gathered around a fireside with Sadr Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya UK. In that warm, open setting, brothers shared their experiences, questions, and reflections, receiving heartfelt guidance from Sadr Sahib. It was an unforgettable exchange — honest, humble, and deeply motivating.

Beyond the Ijtemas, the region stayed spiritually active. A virtual Regional Tabligh Talk brought together Khuddam online for an engaging evening of learning and dialogue, emphasising how every conversation about faith can become an act of tabligh. Later in the month, many brothers were blessed to offer Fajr behind beloved Huzoor (aba) in Islamabad — a moment that filled hearts with gratitude and strengthened every attendee's bond with Khilafat.

The month also carried a strong financial and spiritual focus through Maal Ashra, as daily reminders encouraged Khuddam to complete their chanda and promises with sincerity. February ended as a reflection of Bashir Region's spirit — active in service, united in brotherhood, and grounded in devotion.

MARCH

Faith Service Sacrifice



March continued the blessed atmosphere of Ramadan, which had begun in late February and filled the region with a renewed spirit of devotion, service, and sacrifice. Across Bashir Region, Khuddam balanced fasting with acts of khidmat, tabligh, and brotherhood — proving that true strength lies in serving others even while fasting for the sake of Allah.

Early in the month, Khuddam participated in the Faith & Dialogue Conference at Baitul Futuh, engaging in meaningful discussions on how to present Islam's peaceful message with confidence and humility. The event provided practical guidance for tabligh and reminded brothers that every respectful conversation can become a means of spreading truth and love for all.

The region also promoted Hifazat-e-Markaz (Waqf-e-Arzi) sign-ups, encouraging Khuddam to dedicate time to serving at Markaz — a humble reminder that devotion is shown not only through prayer but through action. In addition, Bashir Region supported a fundraising drive, sharing the JustGiving link and campaign messaging across qiadats to inspire collective giving during this sacred month.

Oxford Qiadat took the Ramadan spirit even further through service. As part of the MKA Blood Drive, Khuddam coordinated with the NHS and donated blood at the Swindon Blood Bank on 20 March to help those in need. Towards the final Ashra, Oxford Khuddam and Atfal also donated around 80 kilograms of essential food items — including milk, sugar, juices, and canned goods — to the Swindon Food Collective at the West Swindon Hub.

March reflected the true essence of Ramadan — sacrifice, compassion, and gratitude in every action.



APRIL

Regional Ijtema 2025

April marked one of the most anticipated events in the Bashir Region calendar — the Bashir Regional Ijtema 2025, held on Saturday, 5 April at the blessed site of Islamabad, Tilford. The gathering brought together Khuddam and Atfal from across the region for a day filled with faith, learning, and brotherhood in the serene environment of Islamabad.

From the early morning registration to the final prayers, the Ijtema buzzed with energy and purpose. 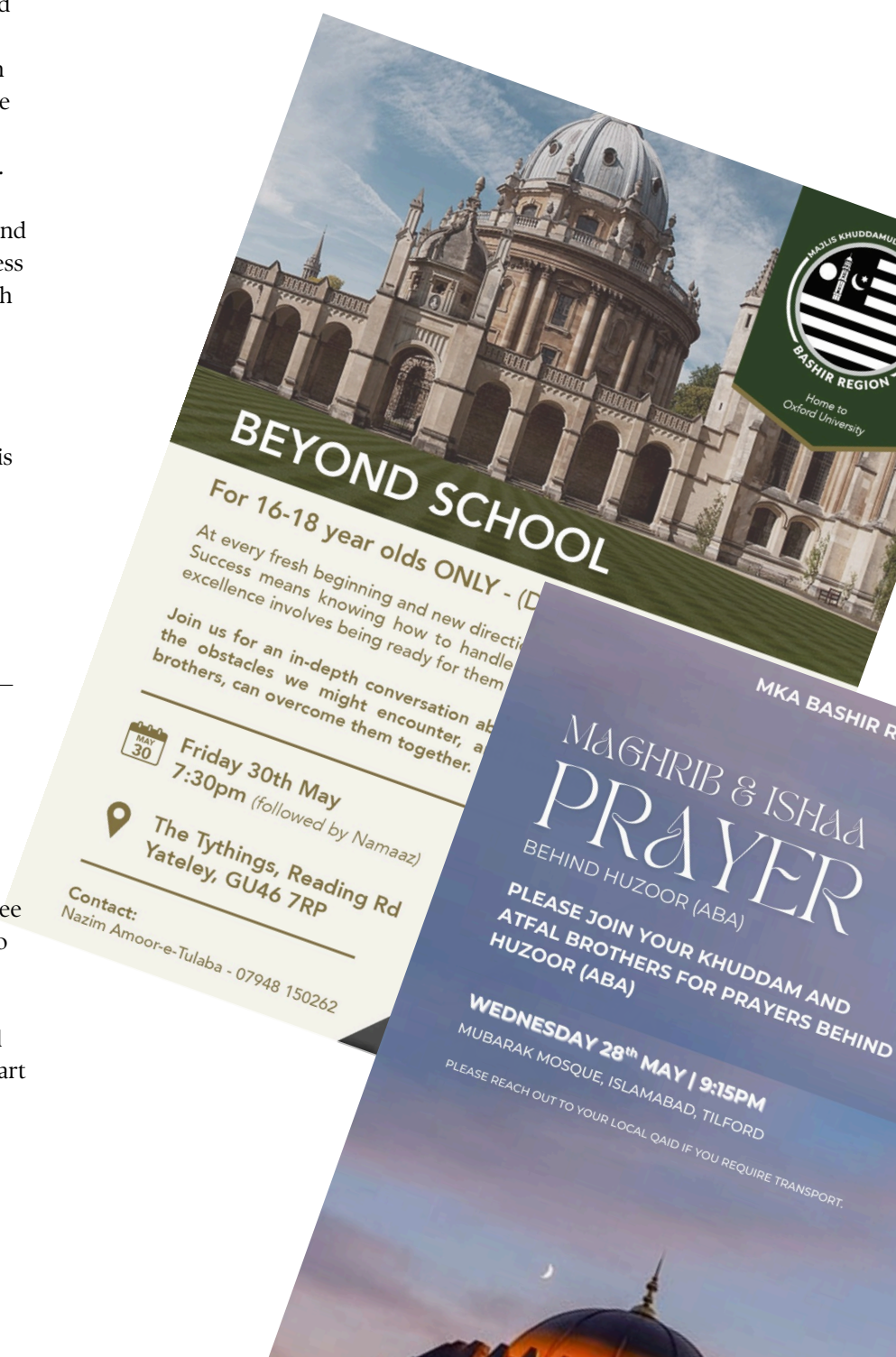
MAY

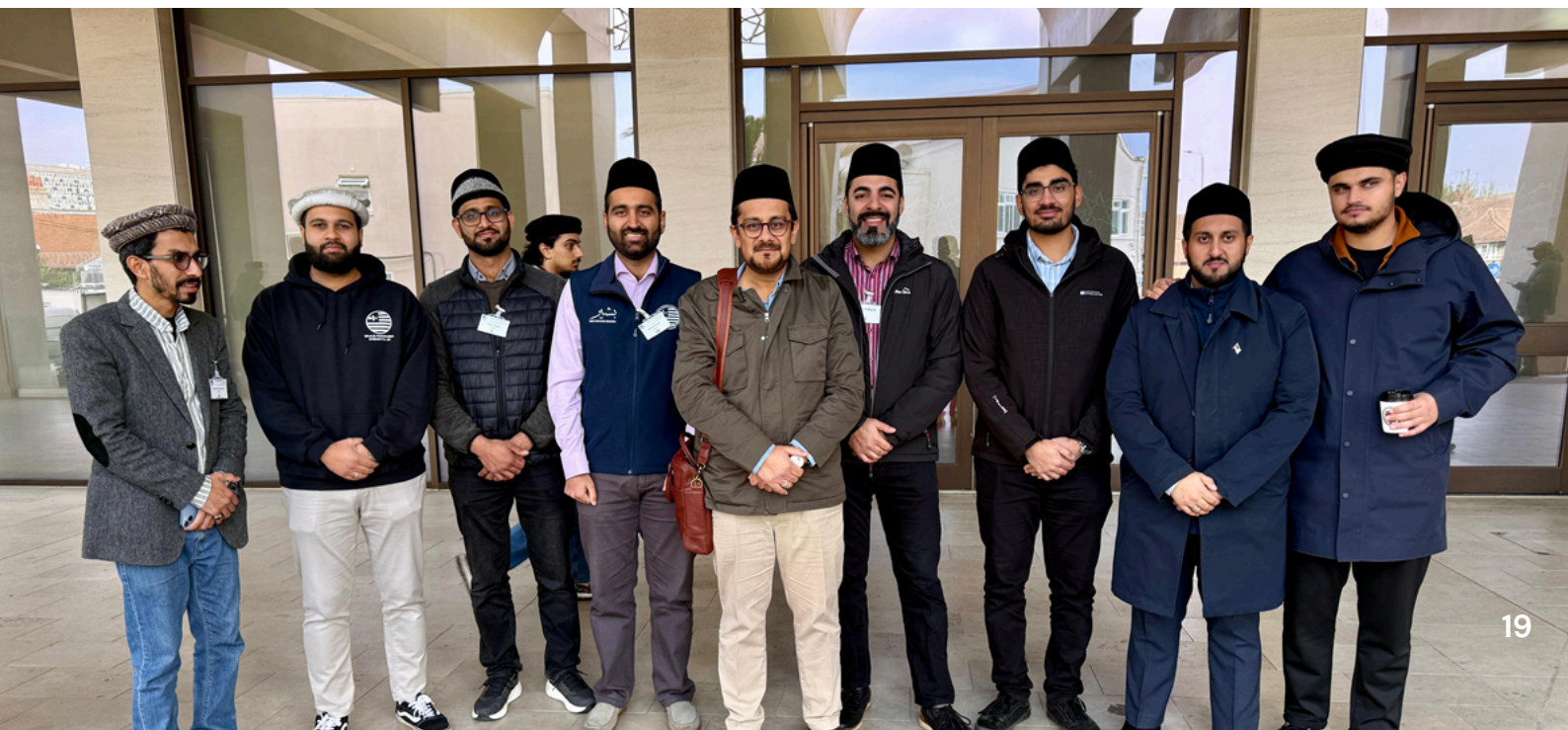
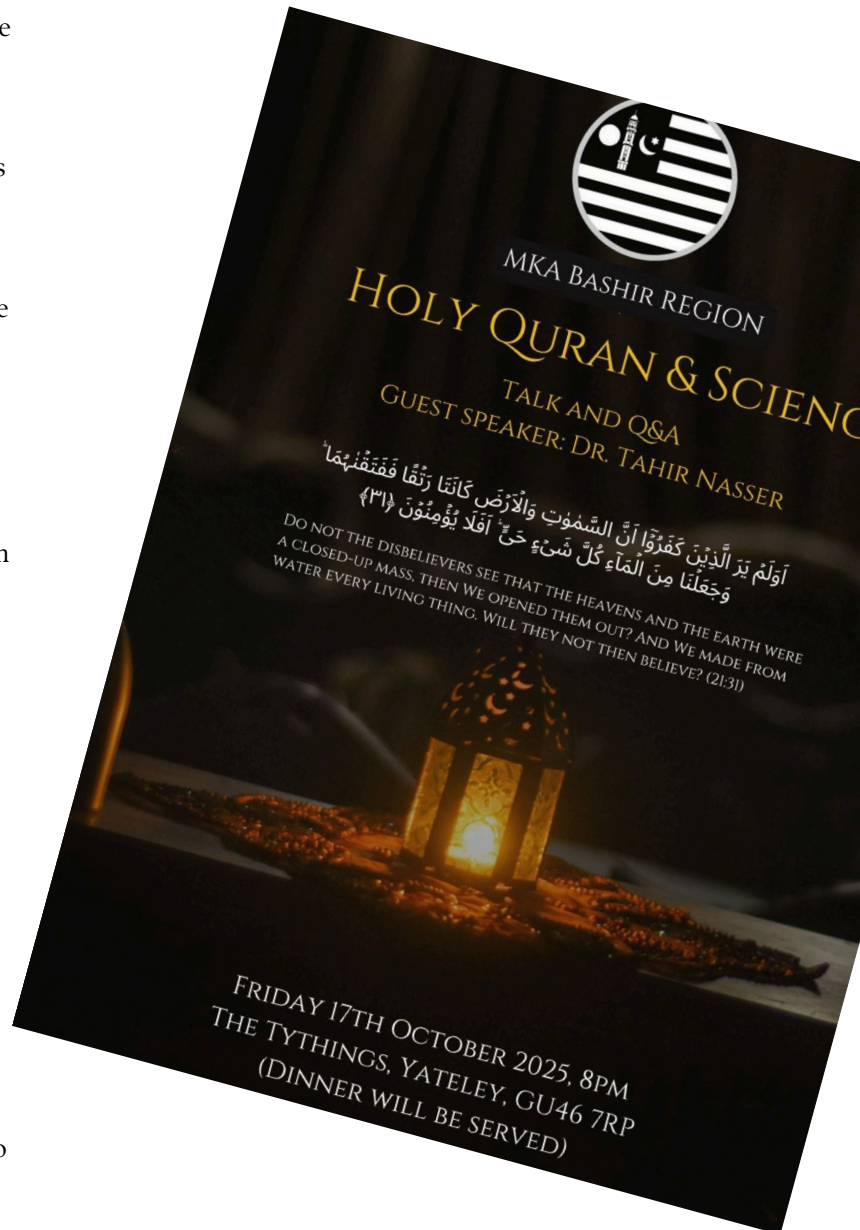
