Hazrat Abu Hurairah^(RA) relates that the **Holy Prophet** ﷺ said:



Salat Habit Week


Final Day – Sunday 1st February 2026

DISCUSSING COMMON ALLEGATIONS
AGAINST AHMADIS IN THE WORLD OF
MISINFORMATION



On Sunday 1st February following Maghrib & Isha'a Prayers, Walton Qiadat held their first ever 'Beyond the Allegations' discussion session with Atfal and Khuddam to engage people about their faith. A total of 12 Khuddam and 5 Atfal attended.

Several Khuddam and older Atfal had seen allegations and hate being spread against Jama'at Ahmadiyyat online, and some had even faced questions and allegations in person. Alongside this, several Khuddam expressed their lack of knowledge to prove the truthfulness of the Promised Messiah ^{AS}, or a true understanding about their faith and wanted a platform where a discussion could be held to truly engage with ways in which they can refute these allegations, especially in the age of misinformation.

Some Khuddam and Atfal had watched videos online through TikTok and YouTube of other people who used verses of the Holy Qur'an and authentic Hadith to refute the allegations placed against the Jama'at. Not only did the Khuddam and Atfal find this content engaging but also expressed a wish to want to learn more and understand more about their faith.

During the first discussion session, the presenters, which included Local Qaid sahib, discussed the various common allegations which Ahmadis (and especially Khuddam) face day-to-day.

These included the finality of Prophethood of the Holy Prophet Muhammad ^{SA}, and the claim of prophethood made by Hazrat Masih-e-Maud ^{AS}. Khuddam and Atfal also discussed the persecution of Ahmadis across the world and especially in Pakistan, and the ways in which Allah the Almighty shows that the true Jama'at always prevails with examples from the time of the Promised Messiah ^{AS}, and more recently from the time of Khalifatul Masih IV ^{RH}.

My Umrah Journey





In the Name of Allah, the Most Gracious, Ever Merciful

Assalamu Alaikum. My Name is Fauzaan Qureshi. I am 13 years old and part of Majlis Atfalul Ahmadiyya Walton-on-Thames (in Bashir Region). I want to share my experience of my first time visiting Saudi Arabia and going to Umrah with my family.

Going on Umrah to Saudi Arabia was one of the most special experiences of my life. Seeing the Kaaba for the first time was one of the most beautiful and emotional moments and I was so grateful that Allah the Almighty had invited me at such a young age. The feeling of thousands of Muslims from all around the world was unforgettable.

First step of Umrah was to wear the Ihram on the plane crossing the Miqat (boundary). We performed seven tawaf around the Holy Kaaba and were able to drink some Zamzam water afterwards.



After Tawaf, we performed Sa'i between Safa and Marwah. This reminded me of the story of Hajar ^{AS} searching for water for her son, Prophet Ismail ^{AS}. It taught me about patience, trust in Allah, and never giving up.


Then the last and final step of my Umrah journey was going bald and shaving my head. Although it was a big sacrifice, I was proud as I did it for Allah. We left Makkah and headed to Madinah where we visited the Prophets mosque, Masjid al-Nabawi, the second holiest place in the world (after Masjid Al-Haram).

This is also Where the Prophet Muhammad ^{SA} blessed grave is located. During this time, we also visited Cave Hira, where the Holy Quran was revealed to Prophet Muhammad ^{SA}. I also had a good time at other areas in Saudi Arabia doing activities such as Camel riding, visiting museums and having many more amazing experiences.

This Umrah trip taught me gratitude. It reminded me that being able to visit these holy places is a blessing that not everyone gets. I learned to be more patient, more thankful, and more mindful of my prayers.

Umrah is not just about the physical acts of worship, but about changing your heart. I returned home feeling spiritually stronger and more connected to my faith. May Allah the almighty grant everyone the opportunity to visit Makkah and perform Umrah themselves and experience these blessings.
