Scenario:

A Christian friend asks:

“All Muslims believe Jesus (as) is alive in heaven and will return physically.”

How will you respond respectfully?

Group Task



- Qur'an 3:145 – All messengers have passed away
- Qur'an 5:118 – Jesus speaks of his death
- Qur'an 21:9 – No human granted everlasting life
- Tawaffa in Qur'anic usage means taking the soul (death)
- Physical ascension contradicts established Qur'anic principles

Group Task



Model Answer:

The Holy Qur'an clearly states that all prophets before Muhammad ﷺ have passed away.

In Surah Al-Ma'idah (5:118), Jesus (as) says: "When Thou didst cause me to die (tawaffaitani)..." which confirms his death.

The Qur'an does not state that Jesus is physically alive in heaven. Rather, it affirms that he passed away like other prophets.

Real Talk Circle



Purpose

To create a safe space for honest discussion, helping Khuddam connect faith with real-life challenges and build confidence in their Ahmadiyya identity.

Scenario

- Many Muslim countries face conflict and division — what does this say about the Ummah's spiritual condition?
- The Promised Messiah (as) came to reform faith, not seek political power — why is spiritual revival more important than worldly control?
- When faith weakens, people turn to anger and conflict — how can prayer and character prevent this?
- Reform starts with individuals — how can Khuddam continue his mission in daily life?

Allegation 1:

“If Jesus (as) is not physically alive in heaven, then why does the Qur’an say: (3:55)
رَفَعْنَاكَ إِلَيْنَا Doesn’t that prove he was raised bodily?”

Help for the answer:

- Meaning of رافع (rafa‘a) in the Qur’an
- Spiritual exaltation vs physical elevation
- Same word used for raising ranks (4:159)
- Context of 3:55 includes tawaffi (death)
- Qur’an does not contradict itself

What Ahmadis actually believe



The verse (3:55) states: “O Jesus, I will cause thee to die (mutawaffika) and will exalt thee to Myself (rafi‘uka ilayya).”

The word رافع does not necessarily mean physical ascension. In the Qur’an, it is frequently used to mean raising in rank or status.

Since the same verse includes mutawaffika (I will cause thee to die), it cannot logically refer to bodily ascension before death.

Therefore, the verse signifies spiritual exaltation and honour, not physical elevation to heaven.


