جس کا یہ ترجمہ ہے کہ محمد صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم صرف ایک رسول ہے اس میں کوئی جزا الوہیت کی نہیں اور اس سے پہلے تمام رسول دنیا سے گزر چکے ہیں یعنی مر چکے ہیں۔ پس ایسا ہی اگر یہ بھی مر کر یا قتل ہو کر دنیا سے گزر گیا تو کیا تم دین سے پھر جاؤ گے۔ تو اس آیت کے سننے کے بعد کسی ایک صحابی نے بھی مخالفت نہیں کی اور اٹھ کر یہ عرض نہیں کی کہ یہ آپ کا استدلال ناقص اور ناتمام ہے۔“

Hazrat Abu Bakr (may Allah be pleased with him) cited the death of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) as an argument by reciting this verse:

"Muhammad is but a messenger; messengers have passed away before him. If he dies or is slain, will you then turn back on your heels?"

The translation of which is that Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) is only a messenger; there is no element of divinity in him, and before him all messengers have passed away from the world, meaning they have died.

Thus, similarly, if he too should pass away from the world by dying or being slain, will you then turn back from the religion?

Then, after hearing this verse, not even a single companion showed opposition or stood up to submit that this argument of yours is flawed and incomplete.

“All Muslims believe Jesus (as) is alive in heaven and will return physically.”

How would you respond respectfully?

Group Task



- Qur'an 3:145 – All messengers have passed away
- Qur'an 5:117 – Jesus speaks of his death (tawaffaitani)
- Qur'an 21:34 – No human granted everlasting life
- Abu Bakr (ra) used 3:144 as universal proof
- No Companion objected

Group Task



Model Answer:

The Qur'an clearly states that all messengers before the Holy Prophet ﷺ passed away.

Hazrat Abu Bakr (ra) used this verse publicly as proof that all prophets die — and no Companion objected.

If Jesus (as) were physically alive, this would have been the moment to clarify — yet no one did.

Therefore, the understanding of the Companions confirms the death of all prophets.

Purpose

Allegation 1:

“If Jesus (as) died, then who will kill Dajjal?”

Help for the answer:

Dajjal described symbolically

One eye = distorted spiritual vision

Represents organized deception

Messiah defeats him spiritually

Allegation Response Battle



Model Answer:

The description of Dajjal is symbolic.

The Messiah defeats Dajjal by breaking the cross
— meaning defeating false beliefs.

This refers to intellectual and spiritual victory, not
physical combat.

Theological Consistency



If Jesus (as) returns physically:

- Is he a prophet? → Yes
- Can a prophet come after Muhammad ﷺ? → No
- Returning prophet = contradiction

Physical return conflicts with:

Khatm-e-Nubuwwat

What Ahmadis actually believe



- Jesus (as) died a natural death
- No human is physically alive in heaven
- Messiah was to appear within the Ummah
- Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as) fulfilled that prophecy
