GENERAL MEETING

AMILA MEETING

The Amila Meeting was held on Tuesday, 23 June 2026, at 8:30 PM, with 11 members in attendance. The meeting reviewed each Amila role, discussed our progress and responsibilities, and reinforced our commitment to working together in serving the mosque and the community.



KHIDMAT-E-KHALQ

During June 2026, Majlis Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya Birmingham West carried out a limited number of Khidmat-e-Khalq initiatives due to increased commitments in other departmental activities. Despite this, efforts continued to support Khuddam and Atfal through transport assistance and chanda reminders during the general meeting, reflecting the ongoing spirit of service, brotherhood, and care within the Majlis.

KHUDDAM & ATFAL TRANSPORT SUPPORT

Regular transport arrangements have ensured consistent Khuddam and Atfal participation in core Jama'at and Qiadat activities, helping to remove travel barriers and encouraging punctual attendance at meetings, Baitul Ghafoor Academy classes, and Waqar-e-Amal sessions. This structured system has strengthened engagement, improved attendance, and supported the smooth running of all monthly programmes. During this period, 8 Khuddam were provided transport for the BW Khuddam General Meeting on 29th June 2026, and 4 Atfal were provided transport for the Atfal Camp on 28th June 2026. In addition, regular transport was arranged throughout the month for Khuddam and Atfal attending Amila Meetings, Jama'at General Meetings, Waqar-e-Amal Sessions, and Baitul Ghafoor Academy Classes.

KHUDDAM GENERAL MEETING

On 29th June 2026, a Khuddam General Meeting was held at Baitul Ghafoor Mosque with 16 Khuddam in attendance. During the meeting, a reminder was given regarding outstanding Chanda and the importance of fulfilling financial responsibilities in support of Jama'at activities. Pick-and-drop transport was also arranged for several Khuddam to facilitate attendance. The gathering served as a beneficial platform for tarbiyyat, engagement, and strengthening brotherhood among members.

TALEEM



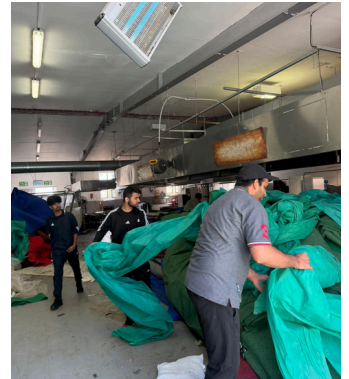
